- ♫ Audition with Music Director
- ♫ Develop own relationship with God through Bible study and prayer
- ♫ Attend quarterly praise team rehearsals
- ♫ Attend all weekly praise team rehearsals
- ♫ Attend all weekly praise team prayer times
- ♫ Perform with praise team on Sunday mornings and other times as scheduled
- ♫ Inform Music Director, in advance, when attendance at rehearsal or service is not possible
- ♫ Commit to be a part of praise team for entire 2010-2011 year (June 2010 – May 2011)
- ♫ Dress modestly when praise team is singing
- ♫ Memorize words to all songs we sing
- ♫ Be willing to submit to leadership of this church
- ♫ Be willing to give up other ministries as needed to be in compliance with 7 laws
- ♫ Listen to at least one new recording of praise and worship music every 3 months in order to bring one or two new songs to the team
